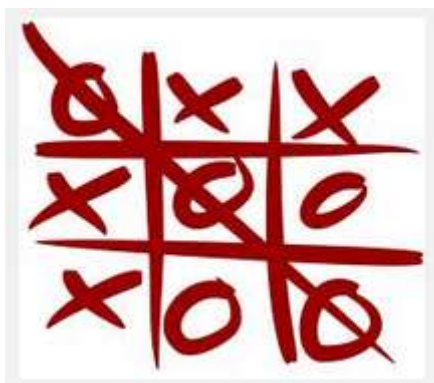


NOUGHTS AND CROSSES
