
## SNOWBALL DEFINITION ACTIVITY

## BASIC VOCABULARY FOR 'THE ANCIENT AGORA'

## Procedure:

Each student has a card. Ss mingle & talk to other Ss, one to another in turn.

In each pair, student A reads his/her definition & student B gives the word. After a while, if student B does not know the word, student A tells him/her the answer. Student B then reads his/her definition, etc. Then they exchange cards & each moves to another student to repeat the same. At the end, the teacher talks to the whole group – asks each students to read his/her definition and the others give the word.
