

INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR ERADICATION OF POVERTY

Poverty is a matter for those countries that are not yet sufficiently evolved enough to feed the entire population; various causes are: lack of income from the state, which cannot finance works that could improve the situation; oppression of backward regions by the more advanced countries; even the mentality of the population itself can affect the non-supply of malnutrition.



An example of this is India, and other countries in Southeast Asia, where poor families are in the habit of cultivating the food to feed more children, and the status, despite revenue enough, fails to provide good nutrition to the entire population.

Unfortunately, this causes them to act their degradation on the cultural level: sometimes you make fun of these people who do not always have to blame; even happen that are accused of vandalism or even criminals, just because they are in this miserable condition.

This situation is created when these people are located in the most developed states of their origin, that is, where the condition of malnutrition and poverty is unknown (or, at least, not completely). You are making many efforts to improve this state of affairs, even with the help of most advanced countries, which allocate funding for the poorest regions; but this is not enough to compensate for the damage caused by multinational companies or the same mentality of the people living in the states concerned: companies should stop this exploitation of their activities, often uncontrolled, resources that belong to a region that needs it most , to give him the chance to recover economically.



While the governments of the countries where the problem of poor nutrition and the misery is due to a continuous increase in population should adopt a policy of birth control.



The problem of hunger and poverty not only leads to suffering but also it leads to the convictions of a cultural, moral or civil problems which in the long period it could lead to even greater risks: the wars fought for this reason have been a lot, and many wars are going to happen.
