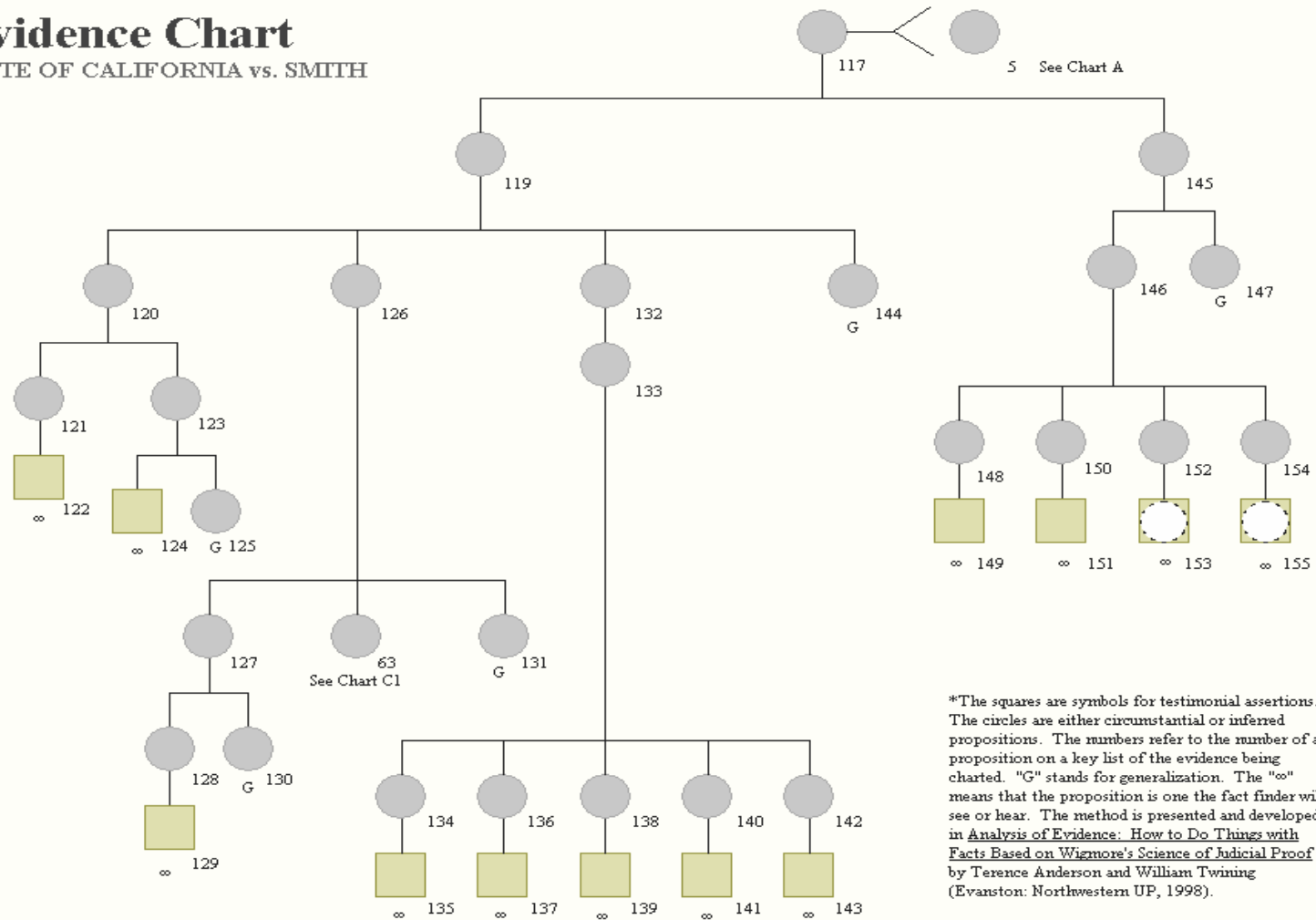


Evidence Chart

STATE OF CALIFORNIA vs. SMITH



*The squares are symbols for testimonial assertions. The circles are either circumstantial or inferred propositions. The numbers refer to the number of a proposition on a key list of the evidence being charted. "G" stands for generalization. The "∞" means that the proposition is one the fact finder will see or hear.
